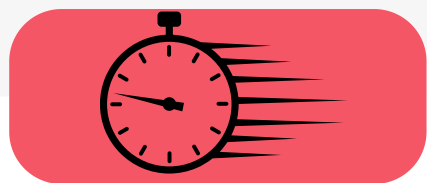
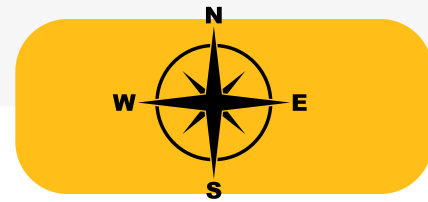


Types of Prepositions

She walked **towards** the park



Location

The cat is sitting **on** the table.



Place

The keys are **in** the drawer.

Preposition of Time

AT

- Times of Day
- Mealtime
- Holidays
- Expressions



at 3 o'clock

Examples:

At 3 o'clock
At Lunch
At Christmas
At Present



IN

- Months
- Seasons
- Years
- Decades/Centuries
- Long Periods
- Part of the Day



Examples:

In the morning/winters

ON

- Days
- Dates
- Part of Specific Days

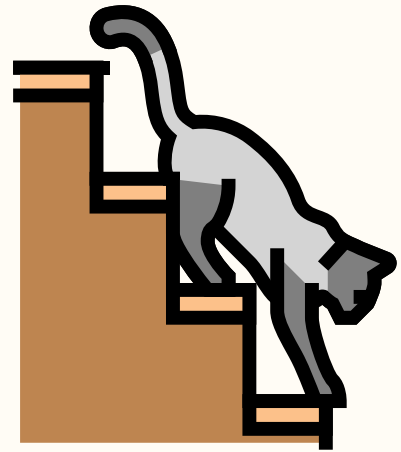
Examples:

On 9th June

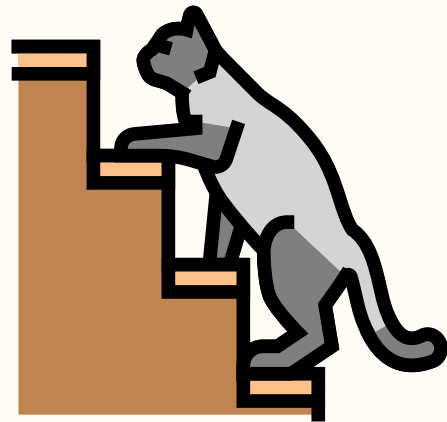


Preposition of Direction

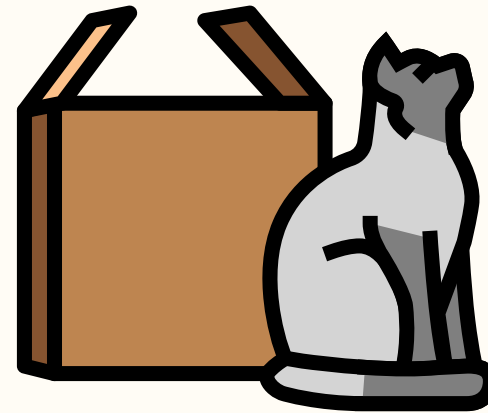
Down the Stairs



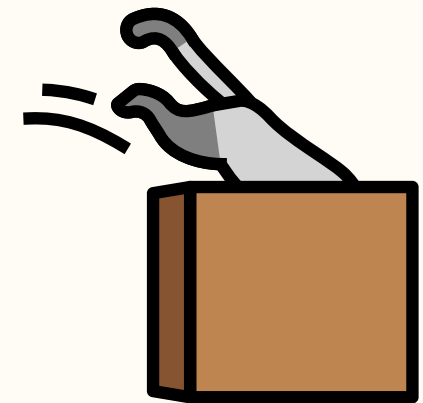
Up the Stairs



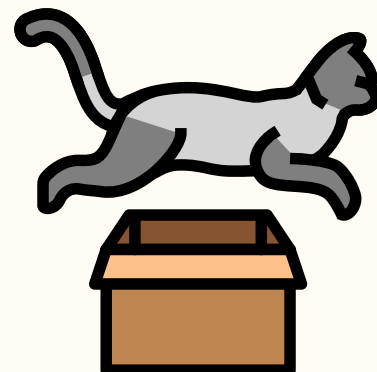
Out of the box



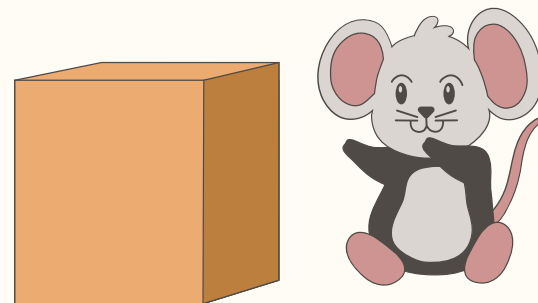
Into the box



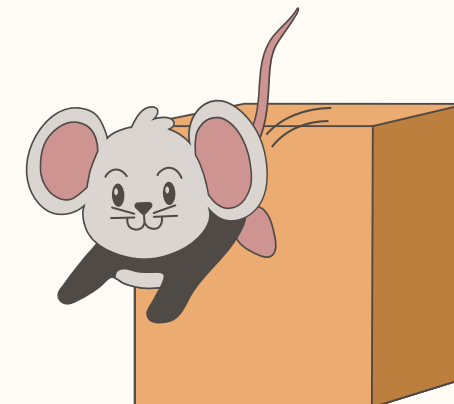
Over the box

At Specific Location

Eg., I'll meet you **at** the Main Street Bus Stop



In Enclosed Spaces

Eg., Children are playing **in** the yard



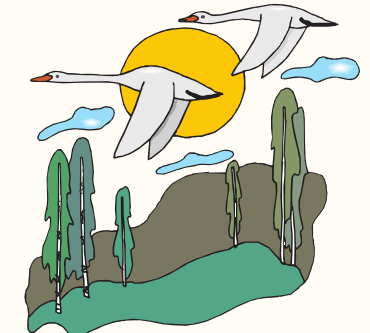
On Surface/Platforms

Eg., Painters are painting **on** the wall



Above Higher Position

Eg., Birds are flying **above** the valley



Below Lower Position

Eg., The fish are swimming **below** the surface



Behind At the Back of

Eg., The secret is hidden **behind** the door



Between in the Middle

Eg., The house is **between** two trees

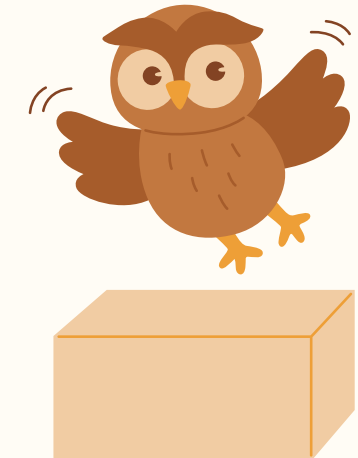
