Countable nouns are the workhorses of our vocabulary, allowing us to talk about things we can count! Imagine a basket full of apples – you can easily count *one apple, two apples*, and so on.

How to Identify and Use the Countable Nouns?

- These nouns have singular and plural forms, often indicated by adding an "s" or "es" to the singular form (e.g., book, books; box, boxes).
- We can use them with determiners like "a,"
 "an," "some," or "many" to specify quantity.
- Countable nouns are essential for describing the world around us, from people and places to objects and ideas.
- They help us keep track of the quantity and individuality of things we encounter.
